1. PURPOSE

The Eastern Cape Provincial Heritage Resources Authority (ECPHRA) hereby invites suitably and experienced service providers to submit quotations for the services of Ground Penetrating Radar, for the purpose of scanning the grave site and detect disturbance or human remains.

2. BACKGROUND

The Eastern Cape Provincial Heritage Resources Authority (ECPHRA) is an entity that was established in terms of the National Heritage Resources Act (NHRA) Act No. 25 of 1999. ECPHRA is responsible for the management of heritage resources in the province. As a responsible heritage authority, its mandate includes but not limited to identification, documentation, and assessment of heritage resources, developing policies and conservation plans, and maintaining essential national standards for the management of heritage resources.
